Call for Applications – EPHAR Summer School 2026

The EPHAR Executive Committee is pleased to announce the **first edition of the EPHAR Summer School**, which will take place in **Ankara, Türkiye, from 9-12 June 2026**, in collaboration with the **Turkish Pharmacological Society, Hacettepe University, and Ankara University**.

This new initiative has been launched to support and inspire **early-career researchers in experimental pharmacology**. The programme will primarily focus on **hands-on practical training**, aimed at strengthening participants' scientific background and research skills. This will be complemented by an **intensive theoretical programme**, including a full symposium day delivered by members of the EPHAR Executive Committee.

The Summer School will host **up to 25 participants**, mainly **first- and second-year PhD students**. Each EPHAR member society is invited to **nominate one candidate**. Travel costs should be covered by the nominating society, while **EPHAR will cover accommodation expenses**. **Lunch and dinner will be provided by the Turkish Pharmacological Society**.
